MS Anti-Bullying Grant Initiative: A plan has been established to implement the “Second Step” curriculum with an emphasis on “Anti-Bullying” within the middle school. Mrs. Eid, Mr. Luebs & Mrs. Rebak will begin to integrate the anti-bullying curriculum within their Art and Health classes. The goal is to have all middle school students involved to eliminate bullying and gain the necessary skills to work through problems that are a result of being bullied.

Reading/Language Arts & Math RTI update: The teachers continue to plan and work in groups to support the school’s RTI (Response to intervention program) process. We continue to review data from various assessments to identify where students are performing and then providing them with interventions to increase their academic rigor.

The Middle School Math and Language Arts staff is now meeting once a week with their groups to review and build capacity on skill development for students who need the extra help within the two subject areas.

The PBIS Tier 1 school wide team has been working on reviewing student data to determine what areas of student behavior is working well along with assessing the negative behaviors within school that we need to improve upon. The Check-in and Check-out program is in place with students assigned with mentors to work towards improving their day to day academic and personal behaviors.
