SUBJECT: December District Administrator Report

1. Superintendent's Coffee Chats

Superintendent's Coffee Chats were held at the LaPointe Library, Legendary Waters and the Egg Toss. There was a full meeting room at the LaPointe event and no attendees at the Legendary Waters and Egg Toss events. Conversations about staffing, food service, communication, curricular opportunities and the District's budget took place during the Coffee Chat. Coffee Chats are scheduled to take place again in the spring.

2. Effectiveness Project

Implementation of the Educator Effectiveness evaluation system for teachers and educational specialists is in its second year of full implementation. Staff members currently worked under the Educator Effectiveness Program have developed Student Learner Outcomes (SLOs), Professional Practice Goals (PPGs) and are in the process of conducting student/parent surveys to get feedback. The online format continues to evolve as full implementation takes place. Bayfield staff are using a program called My Learning Plan to manage the Educator Effectiveness components.

3. Strategic Planning Update

We are working with Kevin Stranberg to firm up the plan for the District's next iteration of the Strategic Plan. The preliminary plan calls for a comprehensive online survey to be developed. This survey effort would involve people from all stakeholder groups. The tentative plan calls for the survey to be administered early in 2017. A School Board retreat will be scheduled in the February/March 2017 timeframe to develop a revised plan based on the feedback received.

4. WASB Convention
