SUBJECT: June District Administrator Report

1. Employee Handbook

The 2016-17 update on the District's Employee Handbook has been revised and will come before the Policy Committee and School Board for a first reading this month. The update included staff input from throughout the year.

2. Superintendent's Coffee Chats

The spring series of the Superintendent's Coffee Chats took place in May. One person attended the May 24th session at LaPointe Library. Nobody attended the May 25th session at Legendary Waters. Two people attended the May 26th session at the Egg Toss. While attendance was low this spring, The Coffee Chats continue to be a good venue for parents and community members to ask questions, share concerns and receive important information about the Bayfield schools.

3. Notice of Insurance Renewal Rates

We've received work from M3 on health and dental insurance renewal rates for 2016-17. The Delta Dental renewal shows a 9% increase. The WEA Trust health insurance renewal shows a 7% increase. The preliminary District budget approved last month was built with a proposed increase to dental insurance of 10% and health insurance of 8%. The District has been very fortunate over the past three years with 0% increases or even reduction of rates.

4. Science Curriculum Development

Teachers have been working very hard to develop Science outcomes and benchmarks based on the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). The School Board will receive the proposed outcomes and benchmarks for consideration of adoption at this month's regular School Board meeting. Teachers will work on developing units of instruction in support of curriculum benchmarks and outcomes. The teachers involved have done a great job with this entire process.
