

IT Systems Administrator Report

The beginning of the school year was marked by my absence on medical leave. I am back full-time, and getting caught up.

1. The next stage of upgrades to our network infrastructure was completed this summer – additional network jack were added in the high school wing, including rewiring the high school office.
2. I was on medical leave for approximately six weeks starting in September. The District contracted Scott Griffiths to do some work as needed, and the LRC staff took care of some of the day-to-day tasks in my absence. I worked remotely as I was able, and I am now back full-time.
3. Work is ongoing on deploying new equipment purchased over the summer, including iPads for Special Ed classrooms and two new core network switches. New computers have already been installed in Middle School Alternative Ed, the library, and some classrooms as needed.
4. The current state reporting cycle is nearly complete, as I clear up issues revealed in the final state review. These reports include submissions for the Individual Student Enrollment System (ISES) for 3rd Friday of September, 2014-15 year end, 2014-15 Discipline, and October 1st Child Count.
5. The security camera system was updated over the summer, and several cameras that were having problems were rewired and/or replaced.
6. This year's projects will include the continued upgrading of network infrastructure to handle the ever increasing needs for internet access, and the scheduled replacement of equipment.
