Facility Update:

We continue to break monthly use records. For example, we had 2499 visits in October of 2014. This October featured 3171. We are on track for 45,000 visits for the year. We averaged 30,000 in our first few years, so we are seeing a 50% increase in use since 2006. Today, we have over 800 members.

RFR is very excited to discuss the idea of a building expansion with the school board, and will present a report at the January board meeting.

Hunt Electric has finished installing new LED lights in the racquetball court. These lights save electricity, will last decades with no bulbs to replace, and don't need 5 minutes to warm up. Hunt is also installing new LEDs and sensors for our outside parking lot lights and front door lights. We will be needing a new controller for the hot tub. The current one is not giving reliable readings and has presented significant problems for our staff.
