SUBJECT: January Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: With the mild weather, we have been able to repair many roof leaks and was also able to fix two exhaust fans on the roof. The new boilers and pumps are working well, although adjustments will continue until we get winter temperatures. The alarm system that is connected to the boilers, pumps and water temperature is also working, as it called out two times last weekend. One of the high limit switches on boiler #2 had a set-point that was too high. All was OK after I adjusted it and the alarm worked as it should.

Transportation and Vehicles: Bus #2 had no reverse gear on a class outing two weeks ago. Turned out to be a shift cable. This is the last year for bus #2. It is going to graduate. I will look at options to replace it with a smaller, maybe used bus this summer. All other vehicles have been serviced during the holiday break.

Safety and Crisis Management: Fire Alarm: Northland Fire was able to download the information off of our panel so he will try to upload it to a new/old style panel for us to use. I will have more information as they work on it and will hopefully have prices for Finance Committee meeting on Thursday.
