SUBJECT: December Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: Now that cold weather has arrived, a few heating bugs are surfacing. There are five room units that have intermittent troubles that are hard to duplicate so we are throwing parts at them until the trouble is gone. The solar domestic hot water make-up heating system has failed and will need pump and pressure tank and maybe a controller and valve. I will disconnect it until next summer because I don't see a need for it in the winter. On a positive note, the locker room units are responding and now heating the locker area. These have not worked for as long as I have been here.

Transportation and Vehicles: Bus transportation is in good shape and I will call Jeff Benton at the tribe to talk about plowing and sanding issues we have had in the past. The Ford van will get new front snow tires this week. All other vehicles are in good shape.

Safety and Crisis Management: Winter Transportation meeting to be held on the island to talk about windsled and van over ice transportation. Top topic is replacement of windsled in near future.

Planning and Projecting: LED lighting is coming down in price and I will be looking at replacing T8 bulb units with LED units. The old classroom heating units will be inspected and prioritized for replacement.
