<u>Buildings and Grounds:</u> The new boilers are working great and had to be stepped down because they were putting out too much heat compared to the old ones. There will be more adjusting as it gets colder. The Modine ceiling heater in the Technology Education building has failed and a new one will go up next week.

<u>Transportation and Vehicles:</u> Nothing to report.

<u>Safety and Crisis Management:</u> The island school playground received some repairs and a load of new wood chips spread under fall areas. A stand alone camera will be installed at the main entrance for the elementary secretary to watch as folks come to the front door.

<u>Planning and Projecting:</u> Northland Fire and Safety will do the annual fire alarm inspection on the Technology Education building on November 23rd. They will also check each signal expander in the main building and give us options for repair and replacing our existing system.
