1. **Middle School** – There is nothing to report at this time.
High School:
2. Baseball games have been re-scheduled due to weather, family obligations and ineligibles. Many of the games will be double headers for the rest of the season, and information will be distributed accordingly.
3. Transportation: Lakeshore Buses have been picking up Softball and Soccer players per request of Washburn for away games. I have been in contact with Lakeshore (Amy) and confirm dates and times for games on schedules. Called Amy on April 29, 2015 and asked how things were going for transportation, any concerns, etc. She stated no news is good news and this arrangement has worked very well. It was stated by the Coaches this arrangement has been good also for less on and off buses, etc. Lakeshore has been very cooperative and great to work with for transportation.

8. Winter Athletic Banquet- A successful evening! We had many families attend.
9. Need President, Board of Education or authorized administrator for the Renewal of the WIAA Senior High Membership Application. Due by August 1, 2015. No cost to the district at this time. Given to Sheila Kelly for Dr. Aslyn and returned to the WIAA on May 19, 2015 via email. It was confirmed by Dorothy Sandkey on the same date at 1:51 pm.
10. Received from the Conference Commissioner, Kevin Lajoie the Indianhead Conference Participation Renewal for the 2015-2016 School Year, received May 18, 2015. Turned into Finance Office for payment of \$1,375.00.
11. Girls Basketball Team is continuing working on their Bahamas Trip with fundraising events, getting donations, etc. They are working extremely hard in their adventure.
12. Will set a Fall Athletic Code Meeting for all high school and incoming freshman on Monday, June 15, 2015 at 6 pm in the High School Lunch Room Area. This meeting is

early this year due to the start dates of the upcoming seasons- football first day of practice is Tuesday, August 4, 2015.

13. Coaching Vacancies for Middle School Head Coach Grades 6-8, Middle School Assistant Coach Grades 6-8, High School Assistant Football Coach Grades 9-12, and High School Girls Assistant Basketball Coach Grades 9-12 will be posted in the local newspaper for fall/winter sports in June, 2015.
14. Life Touch Pictures will be contacting me for finalization for Fall Sport Pictures. A tentative date is set for Friday, September 25, 2015.
15. Wrestling singlets are ordered for Wrestling Season next year through Chippewa Valley Sporting Goods, Chippewa Falls, WI on Thursday, May 21, 2015. Have the invoice on singlets and waiting for specific sizes to be ordered.
16. Wrestling Scales were brought to Valley Scale Service, Rice Lake, WI on Friday, May 22, 2015 by Athletic Director, Barb Rebak. Two scales were brought in for calibration and any repairs that are needed. They have not been calibrated since 2011 according to the tag on the scales.
 - a. Update: The older scale is in need of a new battery which costs \$70.00 – a new battery will be ordered to have this fixed. Also, an AC adaptor (electrical) will be replaced on one of the scale. They will call when they are ready to be picked up or shipped.
17. Athletic Director, Barb Rebak met with Washburn Athletic Directors' to go over how the co-op has been going in the various sports the 2015-2016 year. Discussion were held on the following:
 - a. *Wrestling* Transportation to and from Washburn for athletes. It was agreed upon Washburn will get a reservation on the school van for coach(es) to be able to transport students from and to Washburn for practices per Duane Gasperini.
 - b. Washburn brought up: In the year of 2016- 2017 – discussion on the possibility to co-op *Boys Baseball team*. Since both teams have barely enough numbers for a full team. Each team has approximately 8-11 players this season, and looking down the road- this may be a possibility for combine. Discussions will continue on this next year.
 - c. Discussion on 2016-2017 for a co-op for *Cross Country Team*, both boys and girls. Bayfield had only a hand full of students participating this past year and with the co-op the student athletes will have the opportunity to have a “team” concept. In Cross Country students can participate as an individual or team competition.
 - d. *Softball*: Discussion was on Softball for next year. Both schools were in agreement in our conversation Bayfield could be the host team for next year. We will need agreements from the school boards and a letter sent to the WIAA for confirmation of the change of host school for next year. Washburn will be

bringing this up to their school board on Monday, June 1, 2015. As we will discuss at our school board on Monday, June 8, 2015.

*We will have to look at having a softball field for next year and getting it into shape for the season. Possible changing dates for games since we have only one field at the present time for baseball by the school.

** It was suggested using the Softball Field in Red Cliff and also using the softball field in Washburn for games.

- e. *Football*: Everything seems to be going good this sport as far as both school and South Shore knows. We have posted in the paper for a new assistant coach for the coming 2015-2016 school year.
 - f. *Middle School Football* – Washburn brought up for discussion they will be talking with their school board on Monday, June 1, 2015 for a Middle School Team concept instead of a club. This is still in the talking stages for discussion.
 - g. Soccer – For both boys and girls soccer, all seems well at this time.
18. Jeff Obst, Golf Pro came to talk with Athletic Director, Barb Rebak, Stacy Peterson and Marilu Stepien on possibilities for the future in getting the interest of students in golf. This is still being looked at.
19. Working with Coaches for supplies and purchase orders for athletics for next year.
20. Working on a 5 year rotation for athletic uniforms. This will depend on condition of uniforms. Proposed rotation is as follows:

 - Uniforms for Middle School will be handed down from the High School.
