SUBJECT: February Board Report

Buildings and Grounds: With the warmer weather the District is saving on heat, snow removal, salt and everything else included with a normal winter. The main entrance door to the Tech Ed building will be replaced this week. It has structurally failed. Also the receiving door is beyond repair and will be replaced with an overhead type door that is less expensive than replacing with a double swing door. Scott Armstrong and I have been investigating a 350 gallon a day leak in the hot tub and a 1800 gallon per day leak in the pool for the past weeks to no avail. We have decided to hire the Leak Detectors out of the Twin Cities to come up and find the leaks.

Transportation and Vehicles: Bus #2 have received a few improvements such as, a new battery tray, new batteries, replaced seat legs on many seats and new column switch. This bus is a 2001 and with the rust it looks 20 years old. The pick up truck is going to need repairs soon.

Safety and Crisis Management: The Virginia Graeme Baker Act for pool drains has resurfaced at the pool. I believe Scott Armstrong included this in his report. We will have to have the pool drains re-evaluated and the report sent to the Wisconsin Department of Commence.
