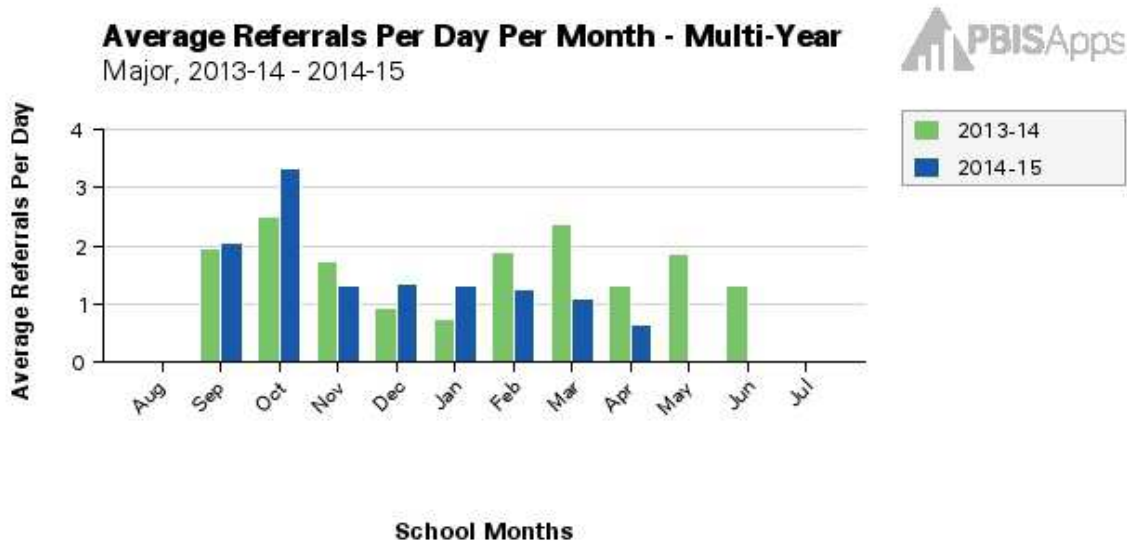

PBIS Referrals: Multi-year numbers below.

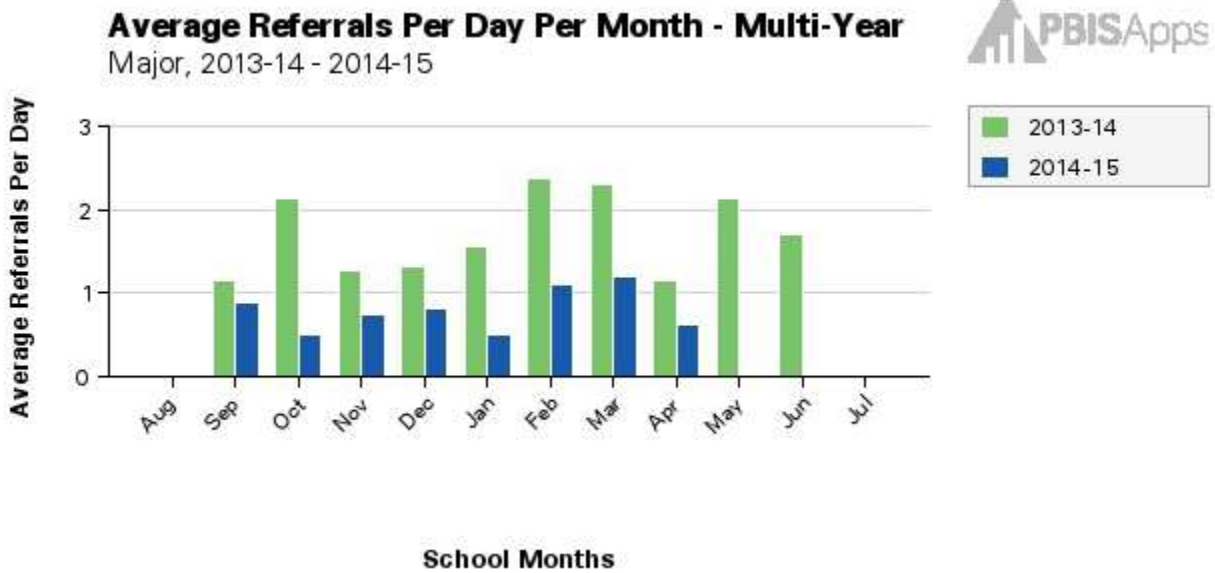

**High School** total Major referrals – 2013-2014 (237) vs. 2014-2015 (225)



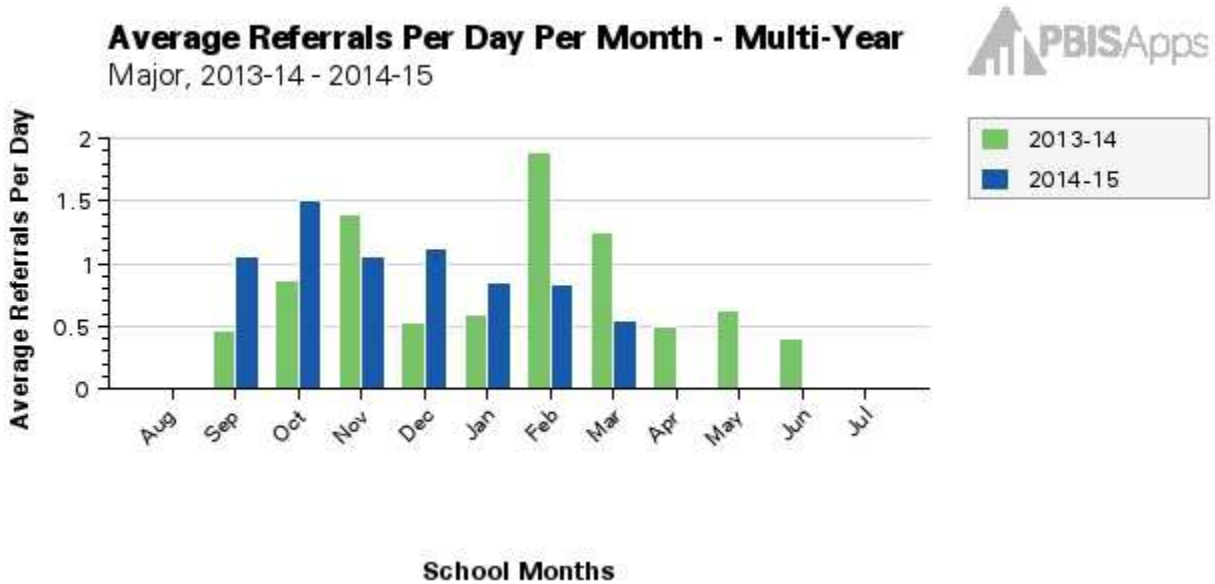
**Note:** The middle school has decreased the major discipline referrals from the previous year. Great Job!
