PBIS Committee Meetings: The PBIS school wide team held meetings in October and November with great success. The committee has been very active reviewing SWIS data to determine where strengths and weaknesses are in grades K-12.

New PBIS Coaches and PBIS Coordinator trainings: We have identified PBIS Tier 1 & 2 trainings for our coaches and teachers for the upcoming months ahead. Staff will be attending trainings offsite to learn about the PBIS process and how it's integrated into their classrooms.

PBIS refresher workshops are now offered to our K-12 staff members. We have set-up two workshops in the month of December for staff members who would like to review and "ask questions" with the program. This is our first time offering this to our teachers and support staff; hopefully, the turn out will be there to continue on with more training in the future.

The coaching staff is meeting weekly to review the PBIS data to determine what the strengths and weaknesses are schoolwide. They are communicating their data summaries by placing information in staff mail boxes and via emails. This seems to work out great for teachers and support staff that either use one or other form of collecting information. The summaries provide the staff with a picture of what is 'happening today.' This provides grade level teams the ability to review and discuss at grade level meetings and plan accordingly in their classrooms.
