PBIS Tier 1 & 2 Committee Meetings:

The PBIS Tier 1 school wide team held various meetings to start the year off with staff and students reviewing the rules and expectations of the program. The program started with a K-12 all school celebration in early September lead by Karen Grieve, K-8 Guidance Counselor, and the school wide PBIS team. The kick-off program was a success and fun for everyone involved.

A discipline referral form is a process to encourage the necessary feedback provided to the student and parents to correct or teach proper behaviors in the school building.*
