Bayfield has been awarded the Safe and Supportive Schools Grant. It totals \$45,000 to be used over three years. Tom Steckling, Anne Sullivan and I will be attending the summer institute on June 21 and 22 in Madison.

We have worked on the Disproportionality plan and it will be submitted next week. It is my hope that we can look at the needs of our school and develop our plans for both Disproportionality and the Safe and Supportive Schools so that we can concentrate on the same needs.

I will have a detailed list of the students in and out of special education for the July meeting.

There is a leadership conference this summer to move forward with the PBIS plan. I am hoping to have a team together to attend the conference in August.

We are currently looking at doing a cluster inservice next fall with Washburn and South Shore. A representative from CESA 12 will be presenting information on the Core Curriculum Standards. Some of the staff have taken the Phase 1 portion of the training already, but they may be called upon to assist with the presentation on August 30.

I have been working very hard with the special education teachers to bring closure to the school year. Due to the number of late IEP meetings the teachers are working quickly to complete the paperwork before the end of the year.
