The application for the Four Year-Old Kindergarten program has been submitted. This is for the start-up grant. This does not obligate the district to this program as of yet. But it does make the school eligible for the grant. These monies would be available in June 2016. We still have a number of concerns work through before we can finalize this program. We are continuing to work on this and will get the information to the board as soon as possible.

We are continuing work with the School Age Parent Grant. Beth Kasinski is working as the coordinator for the program. We will have someone from DPI here to talk about the grant on April 29th.

Dave Doering will be representing the school at the Math Conference in Green Lake in early May to discuss how the C-Tech program is being used in the Bayfield School. He is now teaching the second series of the C-Tech program. This covers copper cabling.

Our annual conference on Disproportionality will be held on April 23 and 24th. The following people will be attending the conference: Anne Sullivan, Lorie Erickson, Doug Jardine, Nancy Larson, Tracey Basina, and I. Marianne Szot, Education and Abilities Manager for the Red Cliff Early Childhood Center will also be attending with us.
