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With the RtI program moving forward for providing students with interventions, we are also working on the focus of students who may need enrichment. I have been working on process and procedures for finding students who may be eligible for additional services for the Gifted and Talented.

The district has been purchasing a variety of intervention programs to be used for the RtI program. With some great work by the custodial staff, who built some wonderful shelving, we will have an intervention library in place for the school year.

With the Inspire grant (school age parent) there has been some interaction with students during the summer. Beth Kasinski, program coordinator, has also been reaching out to school age parents who have not been attending school to try to come up with an alternative program for them so they are able to graduate. Another part of this grant is to work on prevention. We have started to take a look at our Human Growth and Development program. More information on that program will be coming to the board soon.

The contract with New Horizons for mental health services has been signed. Dr. Aslyn and I met with staff from New Horizons to work on any needs that they will have for locating in the school and taking care of some of the details that come with this service. Katy Gorman will be presenting the information to the staff on one of our first inservice days.
