Grant Projects:

- TAP – The last day of TAP for the year was Thursday, May 16 – it was a great year with increased attendance and homework completion in the elementary school. I'm currently working on the re-application for next year (Year 5!) and the year-end data report for PPICS.
- Safe and Supportive Schools – Working on end-of year report and re-application for 13-14. Hallway monitors to display PBIS and S45 will be purchased and installed prior to school start. Traverse wall on schedule for installation last week of June. Five staff will be attending the Summer Institute in Madison June 17 & 18.
- Ojibwe Language Grant – This project has made great progress this year with language integration into classrooms through speech, projects, signage and student and teacher language contests. The first Ojibwe language assessment was conducted last week with 3 kindergarten students. As part of the teacher training, there will be a video produced.
- Farm to School – The school community garden received a \$1900 grant from BCEF for garden projects to be built by high school students.

Summer School:

- 5 weeks of summer school is planned at this time.
- Adding Summer Food Service Program – free to all students 18 years and younger.

Upcoming Grants:

- Charter School Planning Grant – next meeting to start planning will be scheduled before the end of June, 2013.
