SUBJECT: June District Administrator Report

1. Strategic Plan Update

The first informational mailing regarding the District's Strategic Plan was mailed last week. The first mailing included the District's mission statement, vision statement, beliefs and strategic priorities. The limited feedback received so far has been positive. The next edition is scheduled to be sent out in late June. A second edition will be sent in early August. The next two editions will provide information on the goals, strategies and measures for each strategic priority.

2. Workmans Comp Update

We've received the initial renewal for next year on the District's Workmans Comp Insurance. While the bottom line will increase due to increases in payroll, we will not see a significant premium increase as we did last year. Insurance renewals will come before the Finance Committee and School Board this summer for consideration.

3. Superintendent's Coffee Chats

The spring series of Superintendent's Coffee Chats have been scheduled for the first week of June. The schedule is 10:15 a.m. on Tuesday, 6/3 at the LaPointe Library, 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, 6/4 at the Egg Toss and 10:00 a.m. Friday, 6/6 at the Legendary Waters. Coffee chats provide an opportunity for community members to share/receive information, get questions answered and share concerns/insights.

4. National School Lunch Program

The District recently received information from the DPI that we would likely qualify for a new National School Lunch Program. The Community Eligibility Provision provides support for school district with high eligibility for free/reduced lunch participation. If accepted to the program, the District would be eligible to provide lunch for free for all of the District's students. The District would be reimbursed for meals through the program. This program is similar to the breakfast program currently in place in the District. The intent is to file paperwork this month to be considered for the program.
