Report to the Board
April, 2013

March 4th, & 5th: Parent Teacher conferences. We had the opportunity to work in collaboration and communicate with our families, universal screening scores for reading and math, third quarter progress and school garden information. The staff at Legendary Waters were very helpful and accommodating to our requests. Attached is a summary of our parent participation results K-12 with a comparison to our fall conferences.

March 6th: JOM meeting held in Red Cliff. Please see attached meeting minutes.

March 22nd: Sarah Nelson from the RTI Center of WI joined us for our RTI meeting and reviewed our progress and provided updates and training opportunities that would be aligned to our process as we continue to implement our RTI initiatives.

PBIS Update: For the month of March our K-5 PBIS data:

Office Managed Referrals: 5 total with 40% of these referrals occurred for defiance/disrespect. 40% of the total referrals were for physical aggression. The frequency from most of the referrals occurred at 10:00 a.m

Location: 20% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 40% in the gym, 20% on the bus and 20% in the cafeteria.

Staff Managed Referrals: 5 total with 60% of these referrals occurred for defiance / disrespect. The frequency from most of the referrals occurred between 10:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

Location: 40% of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 20% in the library, and 20% in the gym.

PBIS Update: For the month of March our 6-12 PBIS data:

Middle School:

Office Managed Referrals: 24 total with 17% for disruption, 29% for inappropriate language, and 29% for defiance and disrespect. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 11:15 a.m..

Location: 62% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 12.5% in the hallway and 12.5% at recess.

Staff Managed Referrals: 54 total with 93% of these referrals occurred for tardies. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 8:15 a.m.

Location: Majority of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom for tardies.

High School:

Office Managed Referrals: 39 total with 23% for out of bounds and 28% of the referrals for disrespect. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 12:30 p.m (10%) and 11:00 a.m. (7%)

Location: 41% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 38% in the hallway.

Staff Managed Referrals: 142 total with 97% of these referrals occurred for tardies. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 8:15 a.m. (47%) and 10:00 a.m (12%)

Location: Majority of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom for tardies.
