March, 2013

February 6th and 20th: Our Middle School students attended their field trips to the ski hill and had a wonderful time skiing.

February 13th: Grades 6-12 Family Night at Bayfield. This was our first Middle and High School family night this year. We had the pleasure of show casing our “Bag of Tricks” team building activities, Cup Stacking competition and our Native American Club.

February 14th: Our RTI team attended morning networking session at CESA 12 with Sarah Nelson. She is the North Regional Technical Assistance Coordinator from the WI RTI Center. Mr. Gordon and I attended the PBIS networking session in the afternoon at CESA 12.

February 15th and 18th: Staff In-Service days. The staff worked with Amanda Popovich on our Curriculum mapping using the Build Your Own Curriculum tool. Teachers worked independently and in small groups. The goal is to have the ELA and Math curriculum maps in place before the start of the new school year.

February 27th: Our Middle and High School students attended the large group band contest under the direction of Mr. Wenz at Northwestern High School. The students performed well earning a 1st Division (Gold) rating.. Congratulations

PBIS Update: For the month of February our K-5 PBIS data:

Office Managed Referrals: 13 total with 46% of these referrals occurred for defiance/disrespect. 15% of the total referrals were for physical aggression. 2 students produced 46% of the total office managed referrals. The frequency from most of the referrals occurred at 8:00 a.m, 10:30 a.m and 11:30 a.m

Location: 46% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 15% in the hallway and 15% on the playground.

Staff Managed Referrals: 14 total with 43% of these referrals occurred for defiance / disrespect. 10 students produced 71% of the total staff managed referrals. The frequency from most of the referrals occurred between 7:45 a.m. – 8:00 a.m., 10:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 1:30 p.m.

Location: 43% of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom and 29% occurred in the hallway.

PBIS Update: For the month of February our 6-12 PBIS data:

Middle School:

Office Managed Referrals: 41 total with 21% for disruption, 19% for physical aggression, and 17% for defiance and disrespect. 20 students produced approximately half of the total office managed referrals. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 11:00 a.m. – 11:45 a.m.

Location: 66% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 15% in the hallway and 12% at recess.

Staff Managed Referrals: 127 total with 87% of these referrals occurred for tardies. 41 students produced 32% of the total staff managed referrals. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 8:15 a.m.

Location: Majority of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom for tardies.

High School:

Office Managed Referrals: 46 total with 46% for out of bounds and 20% of the referrals for disrespect. 24 students produced over half of the total office managed referrals. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 8:00 – 8:30 a.m.(15%) and 10:00 – 11:00 a.m. (32%)

Location: 61% of the office managed referrals occurred in the classroom, 17% in the hallway.

Staff Managed Referrals: 257 total with 98% of these referrals occurred for tardies. 73 students produced 28% of the total staff managed referrals. The frequency for most of the referrals occurred at 8:15 a.m. (41%), 10:00 a.m (13%) and 1:00 p.m (13%)

Location: Majority of the staff managed referrals occurred in the classroom for tardies.
