Elementary Staff Committees:

- ***Elementary PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies) Team.*** The PBIS Team of seven elementary staff (Angela Botka, Lonnie Cameron, Sheila Everhart, Karen Grieve, Lois Hulse, Janine Johanik and Trent Hanson) will meet May 4, 2011 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 220. Staff will continue to evaluate the current process and procedures. CESA 12 staff is assisting in the piloting of SWIS student management computer documentation program. (Data collection and analysis tool). The SWIS initial training will be provided to staff during 4th quarter. Staff went to a PBIS School Site Visit – resources and tools shared. Staff is continuing to review the current Student Behavior Office Referral Form. Staff expressed an interest in developing a document for classroom teachers to record staff managed behavior. Staff Development Time on May 20, 2011 will be dedicated to a PBIS review / overview. Staff will need to attend additional PBIS training opportunities this summer.
- ***Elementary RTI (Response to Instruction) Team.*** The RTI team meeting of eight elementary staff (Angela Botka, Deb Boulley, Sheila Everhart, Melissa Giesregen, Karen Grieve, Vicki Redenbaugh, Anne Sullivan, and Sandy Raspotnik will meet on April 28, 2011 at CESA 12. The Team is reviewing the Wisconsin and Federal RTI guidelines to begin the process of ensuring that appropriate, well-implemented, researched-based best practices are consistently used in each classroom and that proactive identification and interventions are in place for struggling students before learning problems become ingrained. This will allow staff to have the best chance to work with students to close skill gaps. The May RTI Team Meeting will take place Wednesday May 11, 2011 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 106. Staff will need to attend additional RTI training opportunities this summer.
- ***Elementary Reading Instruction and Delivery of Services Team*** The Reading Team meeting of nine staff (Angela Botka, Deb Boulley, Joe Groshek, Elizabeth Hurrell, Betty Juedes, Allison Nyara, Carol Kouba, Laura Bohn and Sheila Everhart) will meet on May 18, 2011 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 214. All K-5 teachers have been given the Daily 5 teacher resource books, access to the Instructional DVD's and viewing guides for three levels: Kindergarten, First/Second Grade and Third –Fifth Grade. Evidence of implementation are seen in Kindergarten, First, Second, Third and Fourth grade classrooms. Teachers are excited. A couple of classroom teachers are willing to pilot Daily Five process for Math Instruction this fall. Staff will need to attend additional Daily 5 training opportunities this summer.
- ***Elementary Digital Textbooks and Technology Team*** The next Textbook/Technology meeting of seven staff (Carol Sowl, Shellie Swanson, Karen DePerry, Kathy Noteboom, Tammy Curran-Weber, June Bavlnka and Sheila Everhart) will meet on May 5, 2011 at 3:30 p.m. in Room 216. Staff will

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continue to investigate the use of e-readers and Ipods as instructional tools. Staff will also analyze the use of workbooks and consumables for instruction. (Blackline masters worksheets vs. hands-on learning).

- **Take One** Staff Professional Development– Congratulations to the Staff for a job well done. Staff mailed their Take One Entries on Friday April 15, 2011. **Take One** provides a standards-based approach for improving teaching practice and links student learning to effective instruction. The Bayfield School District is one of few districts that will have school-wide participation. Educators will work in professional learning communities organized around teaching standards. Carol is to be commended for her leadership skills and dedication to this professional development initiative.

2010-2011 Kindergarten Enrollment Update: On April 20, 2011 Bayfield Elementary enrolled a new kindergarten student. Our total kindergarten enrollment is 36 students. There are two kindergarten classrooms with an enrollment of 18 each. An enrollment of 18 is the maximum allowed by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction Student Achievement Guarantee in Education (SAGE) guidelines. LaPointe Elementary currently has two kindergarten students.

2011-2012 Kindergarten Enrollment Update:

As of April 20, 2011; there are 23 students who are eligible to attend Kindergarten September 1, 2011. Two families have requested testing for early enrollment. Enrollment projections will range from 23-25 students. Students will be divided into two classrooms with 12-13 students. LaPointe will not have any children enrolled in Kindergarten September 2012.

Bayfield Elementary is working with the Red Cliff Tribe Pow Wow committee representative to plan the Third Annual Pow Wow May 12, 2011.
