As of this date we have 105 students with Special Needs and seven students on a 504 plan. We have four referrals that we are in the process of evaluating.

We have begun plans for Kindergarten screening. That will take place on April 23, 2012. The Child Wellness Day at the Great Lakes Visitor Center will not be held this year. We are looking at participating in the Wellness Days at the Red Cliff Early Childhood Center as part of our Child Find.

The RtI Steering Committee meets on a regular basis. At this time we have four committees working on looking at scheduling that will include a time for intervention and collaboration. There are committees looking at assessments, data collection, and teacher evaluations. We are hoping to present the results of these committees at the Inservice day in May.

The Special Education Staff will be looking at our program for next year. We will have a large number of students in the middle school next year. We will need to look at how we are going to staff the programs.
