Work on the Human Growth and Development program continues. The second Community Advisory Board met on February 24, 2015. We had 13 people attend. We developed a mission statement for the Human Growth and Development program. It is as follows:

Develop a comprehensive K-12 education program to give accurate information for the journey through the stages of development and growth reflecting the values and spirit of the community.

We will be meeting again on March 24th to begin the process of examining other curriculums.

As a part of the SOARing grant we are having two book studies. Janine Johanik is leading a book study on the Daily 5 and Angela Botka is leading one on The Café Book. All elementary regular and special education teachers are participating in a group. I want to acknowledge the additional work and time being put in by Angela and Janine. I also want to acknowledge the additional work for Lorie Heckman as she has been scheduling subs for these times.

We had another meeting for the Response Plan. Steve Dunn, Karen Grieve, Missy Eid, Anne Sullivan and I have met and been working on the update for the Response plan.

Currently we have 107 students in special education, eight students have been referred. There are seven (7) students with a 504 plan. Eight (8) students have an at-risk plan.
