## Board Report

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Director of Special Education/Pupil Services

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We currently have 103 students with special needs. There are eight (8) students with a 504 plan and seven (7) with an At-Risk plan. We have had 88 IEP meetings this year.

With the Inspire (School Age Parent) Grant we have been able to bring some students into the school who did not graduate. We recently had one student graduate, one who will now join the GEDO program, and two new students for a total of four (4) students working with the Reading tutor. Erin Tenney and I have been continuing work on the Human Growth and Development program. We have been meeting with a number of committees at Red Cliff to explain our process. We will soon be sending out letters to develop a Community Advisory Board.

The first Pow Wow for the K-3 grade students was held on November 23 and the second Pow Wow was held on December 18<sup>th</sup>. This was a collaborative effort between the Bayfield Early Childhood program and the Red Cliff Early Childhood Center. The students were excited to participate.

We recently attended a training session on the Wisconsin Child Outcome Summary process. This was attended by Lorie Erickson, Tracey Jardine, Doug Jardine, and I. Marianne Szot from the ECC also attended with us. I am very appreciative that Marianne is able to attend training sessions with us so that there is a smooth transition between school and ECC.

Dr. Aslyn and I met with Val Levno and Katy Gorman to discuss the mental health services that are being provided at the school. It seems that everything is working smoothly. There are approximately 30 students receiving services at this time.
