During the 2012-2013 school year in the School District of Bayfield there were 28 incidents which required physical restraint. The incidents involved 5 students, all were students with special needs. All of these incidents were reported to the parent within 24 hours. Each incident was documented and the documentation was made available to the parent within 48 hours. The time of the incidents of restraint ranged from 30 seconds to 5 minutes, with the majority being about 1-2 minutes. There were not any incidents requiring seclusion of a student.

We have 107 students in the special education program. We already have two referrals this year. We will have more accurate numbers on students next month.

We are not fully staffed, we will be interviewing on Thursday, September 5 for an Instructional Assistant position.
