## Board Report

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November 7, 2012

I will be at the Leadership Conference in Madison on November 13 and 14<sup>th</sup>.

The State Performance Plan (SPP) represents the Department of Public Instruction's (DPI) plan for improving outcomes of children with disabilities in Wisconsin. Work within the state is based on activities related to the indicators in the SPP to improve outcomes for children with disabilities. The DPI has designed their plan based on 20 Indicators.

The Department of Public Instruction has developed a web-based IEP: Postsecondary Transition Plan (PTP) that will assist schools in the documenting of postsecondary transition requirements with 100% compliance while allowing for individualization to meet student needs. The PTP is the application for collecting Indicator 13 data (see below). Because state law requires transition plans for students with disabilities aged 14 and above, the PTP is used to develop and monitor transition plans for all students with disabilities who need a postsecondary transition plan. Staff is being trained in its use and we will begin this programming during the month of November.

*Indicator 13: Percent of youth with IEPs aged 16 and above with an IEP that includes appropriate measurable postsecondary goals that are annually updated and based upon an age appropriate transition assessment, transition services, including courses of study, that will reasonably enable the student to meet those postsecondary goals, and annual IEP goals related to the student's transition services needs. There also must be evidence that the student was invited to the IEP team meeting where transition services are to be discussed and evidence that, if appropriate, a representative of any participating agency was invited to the IEP team meeting with the prior consent of the parent or student who has reached the age of majority.*

The self-assessment has been completed and submitted to DPI. We will be working on making the corrections this school year. This process will continue through the year being completed around this time next year.
