

**School District of Bayfield
Impact Aid and Title VII Hearing
Monday, November 12, 2012**

1. Call to Order: The meeting of the School District of Bayfield Board of Education on Impact Aid and Title VII was called to order by Board President Craig Hoopman on Monday, November 12, 2012 at 7:25 p.m. at the Legendary Waters Resort and Casino in the Buffalo Bay Grand Ballroom in Red Cliff.

5. District Administrator Report: Superintendent David Aslyn provided some history and background information pertaining to Impact Aid and Title VII.

6. Public Input, Comments and Questions – Oral and Written

Dee Gokee-Rindal stated that a table of contents would be very helpful in the Impact Aid packet and to receive the packet at least 10 days in advance for review. She indicated she would like to see more comparisons on special needs and disproportionality in the packet.

Jeannie Balber informed the board that she has had a number of issues with bus transportation of her children. She stated that she no longer uses the school bus service to provide transportation for her children. She transports her own children.

Andrea DeBungie indicated that she feels very fortunate to work for the Bayfield School but sometimes feels that teaching cultural identify is not always a priority.

Dee Gokee-Rindal informed the board that by the fall of 2015, a small group of students transitioning from ECC to kindergarten will be able to speak both English and Ojibwa fluently and wants to know what the school is going to do to support this to continue. She stated that currently the district is losing a number of students to the LCO Emersion School in Hayward because of the native language offered there.
