January 16 – 18: Final exams will be issued to our High School students. Staff, students and parents will be notified in advance of the exam schedule.

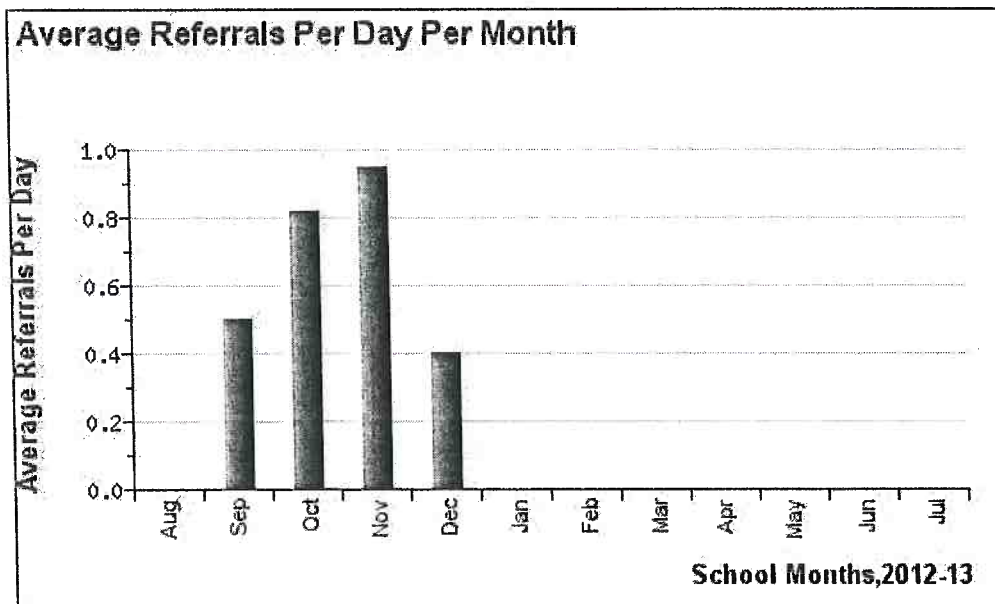

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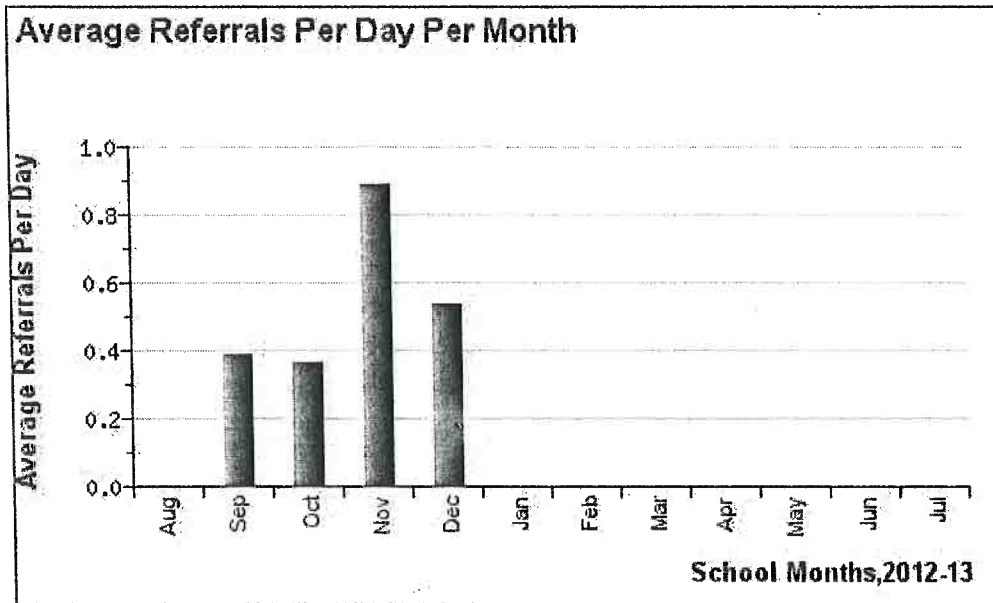
