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K-5 Principal

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports (PBIS) -

In April 2018, at Bayfield Elementary School, there were 11 major referrals among 7 students.

These referrals were for:

- Defiance (6)
- Physical Aggression (4)
- Inappropriate Affection (1)

Referrals by locations:

- Classroom (4)
- Gym (2)
- Playground (3)
- Hallway (1)
- Cafeteria (1)

April data indicates:

- Referrals by time indicate that major behaviors happened around 11:30 and 12:30 and between 3:00 and 3:30.
- Wednesday's had the highest number of referrals with six (6), followed by Thursday's with three (3) referrals, Tuesday's and Monday's each had one (1).
- Referrals by grade: eight (8) referrals happened in the 5th grade, one (1) referral in 1st grade, and two (2) referrals in kindergarten.
- The PBIS coach recommended elementary teachers to regularly confer with their students to identify strategies to reduce physical aggression among students.
