SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

The legal basis for public education in the school district is vested in the will of the people as expressed in the Wisconsin Constitution. Public education is primarily a state responsibility and a local school district's function.

The official name of this district is the School District of Bayfield. The District shall be a joint school district and shall include the city of Bayfield and the towns of Bayfield, Russell and LaPointe, including the Red Cliff Community, in Bayfield County.

Educational services of the District shall be organized as a program of instruction for grades Pre-Kindergarten through twelfth grade. The District shall be operated as a single system by the District Administrator, under the direction of the Board of Education.
