

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD

POLICY DEVELOPMENT

The Board of Education shall adopt policies to guide the actions governing the operation of the school system. The Board shall delegate to the Administrator the functions of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools shall operate. These rules and detailed arrangements shall constitute the Administrative regulations governing the schools within the district.

The formulation and adoption of written policies shall constitute the basic method by which the Board of Education shall exercise its leadership and control over the operation of the schools under its charge. These policies shall be recorded in writing and organized to a standard codification system. A recommendation for policy adoption or change shall be voted on by the Board at two consecutive meetings with a roll call vote. A majority vote of the Board shall be required to adopt, amend or repeal any Board policies.

The District Administrator may, in case of emergency, suspend any part of these policies as they pertain to the administration of the schools; provided that the Administrator shall immediately report the facts in writing to the Board of Education and review said facts at the next official meeting of the Board of Education. The suspension so made shall expire upon the presentation of said report unless continued in effect by action of the Board. The Board may, by unanimous vote, suspend, repeal or adopt any policies without prior notice having been given.

The formal adoption of policies shall be recorded in the minutes of the meeting of the board of Education at which they were adopted and incorporated into the manual of Board policies. Only those written statements so adopted and recorded shall be regarded as Official Board of Education Policies.

Board policies shall be reviewed on a continuing basis in order to keep them up-to-date and to determine if such policies are relevant, practical and reflect the mission and goals of the school district.
