

REGULAR BOARD MEETINGS

The Bayfield Board of Education shall meet on the second Monday of each month. Regular meetings will be held at 6:00 p.m., unless otherwise determined by the Board. All regular Board meetings shall be open to the public.

Notice shall be given for regular Board meetings in accordance with state law and Board policy. The Board shall not discuss or act upon any item of business not included on the noticed agenda.

All Board of Education meetings shall be presided over by the Board President, or in his/her absence, the elected Vice-President, or in his/her absence, a Board member elected from the group at large.

At the request of any member present, action on any new business may upon majority vote be postponed indefinitely or until the next regular or special meeting of the Board.

The length of regular Board meetings shall be limited to a maximum of three (3) hours. The length of the meeting may be altered only by a majority vote of all Board members and only for discussion and/or action on a specifically stated subject or matter. Any motion to extend the meeting shall specify the time of adjournment. Meetings may be adjourned to a specific date, by a majority vote of the Board, for the consideration of unfinished business.
