

SPECIAL BOARD MEETINGS

Special Board of Education meetings shall be held upon request of any Board member. The request shall be filed with the Board Clerk, or in his/her absence, the Board President. He/she shall notify each Board member of the time and place of the special meeting at least 24 hours before such meeting, unless for good cause such notice is impossible or impractical, in which case shorter notice may be given. In no case may the notice be provided less than two hours in advance of the meeting. Board members are encouraged to attend Special Meetings.

Business transacted at special Board meetings shall be limited to the stated purpose of the meeting.

Special Board meetings shall be open to the public. Public notice shall be given in advance of the meeting in accordance with state law and Board policy.
