

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD  
ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCILS AND COMMITTEES

The District Administrator may create councils, committees and other advisory groups for the purpose of developing school programs, implementing Board of Education policy or for whatever other purpose the District Administrator or Board deems necessary.

All councils and committees created by the District Administrator will function in an advisory capacity only. Such groups may make recommendations for submission to the Board through the District Administrator, however, will exercise no inherent authority.

The membership, composition and responsibilities of administrative councils and committees will be defined by the District Administrator and may be changed at his/her discretion.
