DEVELOPMENT AND APPROVAL OF HANDBOOKS

Student handbooks shall be developed to identify school rules and serve as the basis for the enforcement of the rules. Handbooks shall be adopted by the Board of Education and used to ensure that all students, staff and parents are cognizant of the rules used to govern the schools.

All handbooks shall be developed consistent with Board policies and state and federal laws and regulations. Student handbooks shall be referred to annually to the Red Cliff Education Committee for input and approved by the board prior to the start of school.

It is understood by the Board that rules are not all-inclusive. The administration shall take such action as is necessary to insure the discipline and orderly conduct of school students. Action may be taken with respect to any offense which interferes with the orderly conduct of the school regardless of the existence or non-existence of a rule covering the offense.
