### STUDENT SUSPENSIONS/EXPULSIONS

#### Suspension

A student may be suspended from school for noncompliance with school or Board of Education rules; for conduct while either at or not at school or under or not under the supervision of a school authority which endangers the health, safety or property of others at school or under the supervision of a school authority; for knowingly conveying any threat or false information concerning an attempt or alleged attempt being made or to be made to destroy any school property by means of explosives; or for conduct while not at school or while not under the supervision of a school authority which endangers the health, safety or property of any employee or Board member of the District. The District Administrator, building principals or designee shall be authorized to suspend a student for a period not to exceed three school days as provided by law. Except as otherwise specifically provided by law, a student may be suspended for up to fifteen school days, or up to ten days if the student has exceptional educational needs, when an expulsion hearing is pending. The student will only be suspended if it is determined that he/she is guilty of noncompliance with the school rule or of the conduct charged, and that his/her suspension is reasonably justified. Established suspension procedures shall be followed.

Students may be assigned to in- or out-of-school suspensions.

Suspended students shall be allowed to make up any examinations or classwork missed during the suspension period in accordance with the District's student attendance procedures.

#### Expulsion

The Board may expel a student from school whenever it finds him/her guilty of repeated refusal or neglect to obey school rules or regulations; knowingly conveying any threat or false information concerning an attempt or alleged
