

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD**PUPIL IMMUNIZATIONS**

The best interest of pupils are served when all pupils meet Wisconsin's Immunization Requirements. All pupils, including transfer pupils, shall present immunization records as required by law, or shall provide a waiver based on health, personal, or religious reasons. Immunizations shall be required for measles, rubella (German measles), diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), poliomyelitis, tetanus, mumps, varicella (chickenpox), and hepatitis B.

The principal of each school, or their designee, shall have a designee responsible for the maintenance of immunization records, transfer of immunization records and notification of the County District Attorney's office and County Health Department of any non-compliant pupils as well as notification to the parent of possible fines and exclusion from school for non-compliance. The principal and/or his/her designee also shall notify parents/legal guardians of the legal requirements and their right to immunization waiver.
