SUPERVISION OF PUPILS

The school district is responsible for pupils when they are in school, engaging in school-sponsored activities, or traveling to and from school on school vehicles provided and/or contracted for by the District. Such vehicles include, but are not limited to busses, ferries, windsleds, airboats, cars and vans. School personnel assigned to their supervision serve in loco parentis.

Pupils are to be supervised at all times when they are in school, on school grounds, traveling under school auspices, or engaging in school-sponsored activities. School personnel assigned to this supervision are expected to take appropriate action to ensure the safety of the pupils in their charge. No teacher or other staff member shall leave his/her assigned group or individual pupils unsupervised.

During school hours, or while engaging in school-sponsored activities, pupils shall be released only into the custody of parents, legal guardians, or their designees as confirmed in writing or by direct telephone communication.

The school administration shall assure that anyone who wishes to contact a pupil during the school day is doing so for reasons considered legitimate and efforts will be made to limit contacts to non-class time.
