

## **SCHOOL DISTRICT OF BAYFIELD STUDENT AWARDS AND SCHOLARSHIPS**

Students in the School District of Bayfield shall be informed annually of available scholarships and awards.

Students with a full schedule of graded classes are eligible to be awarded recognition on the honor roll by meeting grade point average requirements.

Class rank for the purpose of scholarships, shall be determined by the number of years enrolled at Bayfield High School. Student must be enrolled at Bayfield High School for five semesters prior to graduation to be eligible for major district administered scholarships.

Literature concerning available scholarships and awards shall be posted in the school building.

Criteria for District awards and scholarships shall be developed consistent with District goals and objectives.

The School District of Bayfield shall not discriminate in the acceptance and administration of gifts, bequests, scholarships and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations or persons on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, religion, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established complaint procedures.
