BUILDING AND GROUNDS INSPECTIONS

Safety inspections are one of the principle means of determining possible causes of accidents before they cause injury. Inspections should not be limited to search for unsafe physical conditions, but should also include examination to detect unsafe practices.

School buildings shall be inspected at least annually by the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds and designated building representatives in accordance with established procedures.

Unsafe conditions are to be corrected as soon as possible in accordance with established procedures.
