### FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

Students in the School District of Bayfield shall have an opportunity to participate in school lunch, breakfast and milk programs. These programs shall be administered by the District Administrator in accordance with state and federal guidelines. The District shall enter into agreements with the Department of Public Instruction and/or federal government for participation in the school lunch and milk programs.

The District shall extend the "offer versus serve" option to students in grades K-12. In providing this option, the District elects to permit students to refuse up to two of the five food items (meat or meat alternate, bread or bread alternate, milk, two fruits/vegetables) included in a full school lunch portion.

Food service prices shall be established annually by the Board of Education. In accordance with federal guidelines, the District shall offer free and reduced price food services to students who qualify.

The School District of Bayfield shall not discriminate in school-sponsored food service programs on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, color, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
