WHEREAS, There is a growing public insistence that all levels of government become more responsive to citizen needs and desires; and

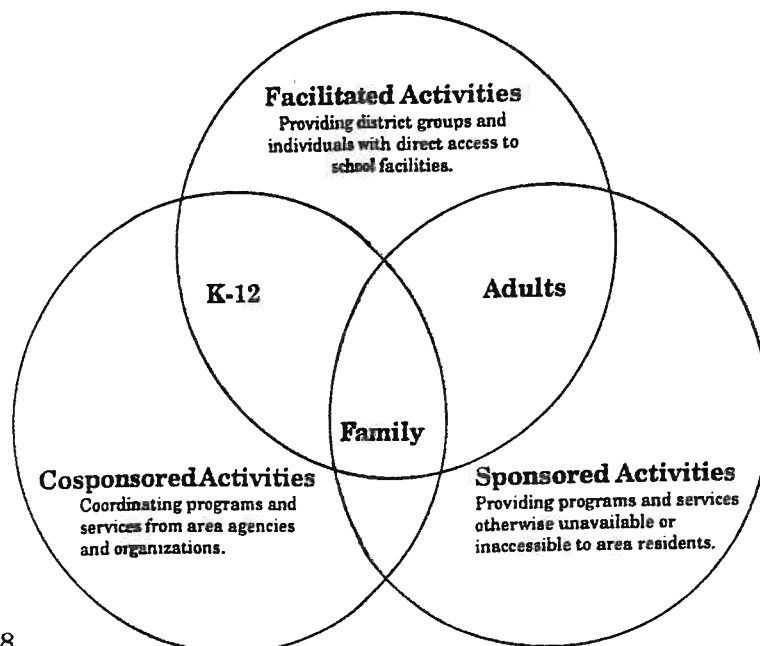
WHEREAS, the amount of tax money and other resources available to meet public demands for facilities, programs, and services is limited; and

WHEREAS, our community has facilities, equipment, and staff organized for the purpose of providing education, recreation, cultural, and service programs for all residents; and

WHEREAS, the board of education believes that there should be a comprehensive community education program that brings together and coordinates the resources organizations, agencies, and groups in the community and that promotes efficient use of school and community personnel, buildings, and equipment; and

WHEREAS, a great potential social and economy; benefit can be derived from cooperation in facility use and program development for the benefit of all citizens through comprehensive community education programs;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this board of education endorse community education as an educational process to serve all age groups in the community and to use the total resources of the community; to develop education, social, and recreation programs and service needed and desired by community residents.
