Achievement

On April 12th four high school students, with Mr. O'Neill, participated in the Ashland Science Fair with two students tying for 1st place and one student receiving a 2nd place finish.

On April 14th high school Forensics students performed their selections for an audience of over 100 parents and community members before their trip to the state competition on April 16th.

On April 16th twenty-nine high school students traveled to Madison to compete in the State Forensics Competition with twelve students receiving gold medals, eight students receiving silver medals, and eight students receiving bronze medals.
