March 14, 2011

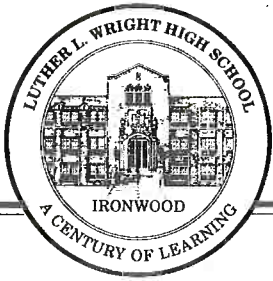
- 1) The boy's basketball season ended on Friday March 4th with a loss to Mellen in the Regional Semifinal.
