

**Athletic Director Report**  
**November 8, 2010**

- 1) Fall sports have concluded. Volleyball hosted a first round regional tournament game and beat Shell Lake. The girls then travelled to Drummond for second round tournament action. The girls lost a close match. Boys Soccer had a very successful year. The boys finished with one loss in conference and won the Northern Lights Conference championship. The boys hosted the first two rounds of the WIAA Soccer Tournament at Washburn. The boys won the first round over Cumberland and lost in the Regional Championship to Washburn.
- 2) Will be interviewing next week for an Assistant HS Girls Basketball coach.
- 3) Middle School Boys Basketball started October 19<sup>th</sup>. We have 12 boys signed up for the sport.
- 4) Attended the Indianhead Conference Administrators meeting at the Steak Pit on October 13<sup>th</sup>. The main items of the meeting were that Bessemer and Wakefield-Marenesco were added to the conference beginning next year school 11-12. Also approved a schedule for Girls volleyball next year whereby there will be east and west divisions. We will be in the west division with Solon Springs, South Shore, Drummond, Butternutt, Washburn, and Bayfield. The conference championship will be determined by the winner of the east and west divisions playing each other for the last game of the season.
- 5) There is some interest in the community for a sports Coop with Washburn in football. A preliminary informal survey of students in grades 8-11 revealed that 20 students were interested. Experience has shown that number is usually much higher than the actual number who participate in that sport. I also received a letter from a parent that I am attaching to this report. There are 12 signatures of parents requesting that Washburn and Bayfield Coop football. One parent requested that there be an agenda item for the Boards consideration. Would like to schedule a meeting with interested parents during the month of November to gauge interest and look at possible issues that would need to be overcome.
- 6) Investigated an incident with a coach at a team function. I have forwarded the results of that investigation to Superintendent Kunelius and my recommendation.
- 7) Will be holding another Athletic Code reading on November 10<sup>th</sup>, at 6:30 PM in the LRC
- 8) Boys Basketball and Wrestling are set to start practice on November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and Girls basketball on November 18<sup>th</sup>.
- 9) There currently is not a position for an assistant cross country coach in the master contract. I am attaching a summary of why we have assistant coaches and would

like to have an agenda item for approval of a position of assistant cross country coach.
