As you are all aware, Bayfield Schools will be closed until April 6 as the result of an order from Public Health. Moving ahead in this time of uncertainty, the district is monitoring the ever-changing situation with Coronavirus (COVID-19). We continue to work with the Department of Public Instruction, state and local health departments, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). We will be offering breakfast and lunch to students during the closure. This will be delivered to community sites starting Thursday.
