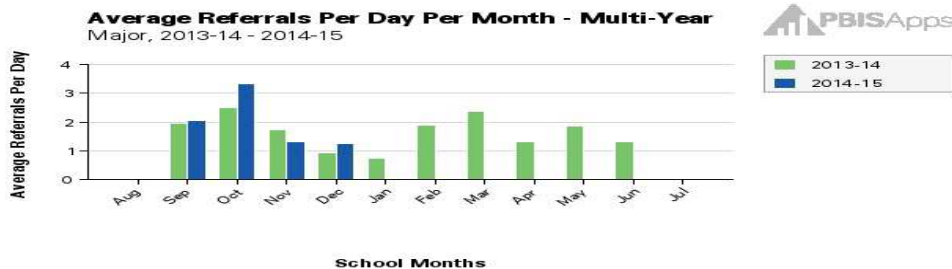

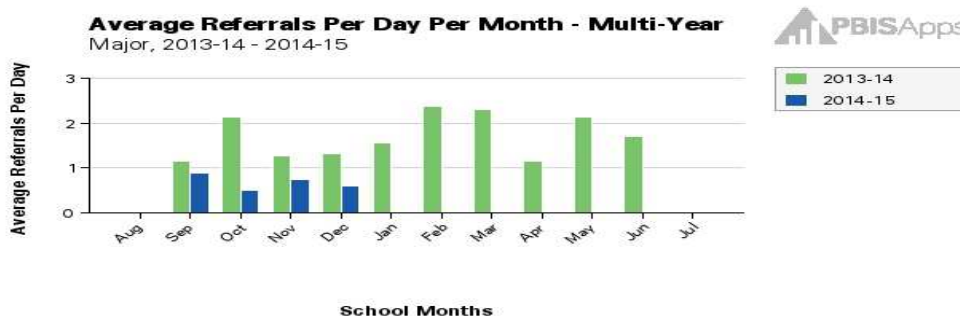
Student discipline major referrals that come to the office regarding student behavior: The graph shows the number of referrals from last year to this year for the months of September through December.

The numbers at the high school have been consistent with last year with a net gain of 16 total office managed referrals. The middle school has dropped in referrals from this time last year with a reduction of 60 office managed referrals.

High School total Major referrals – 2012-2013 (140) vs. 2013-2014 (156) increase of 16 referrals.

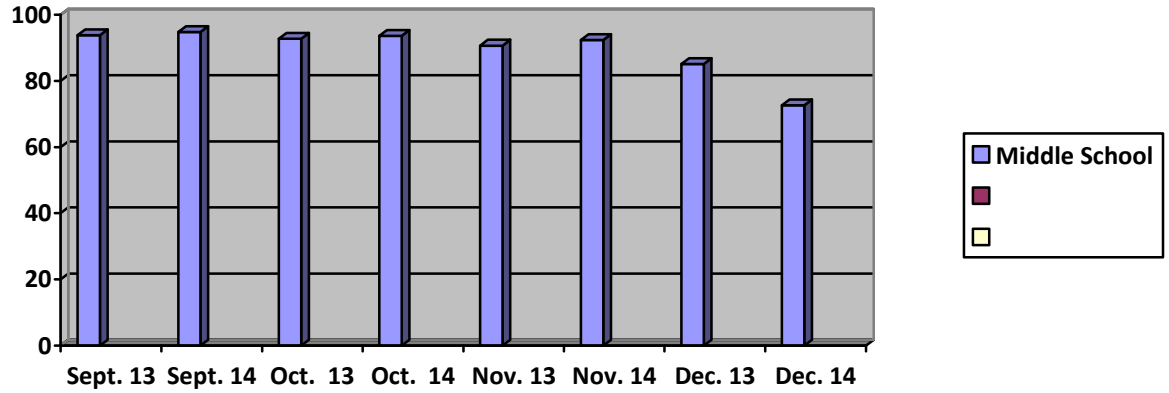


Middle School total Major referrals – 2012-2013 (112) vs. 2013-2014 (52) decrease of 60 referrals.
