

## **School District of Bayfield Board Report**

As of this date there are 111 students in the special education program and five students with 504 plans.

On April 27 and 28 there was a mandatory meeting for the Disproportionality team in Green Bay. Anne Sullivan, Tom Steckling, Doug Jardine, Andrea Bouley and I attended. We worked on our evaluation from last year and will begin plans for the 2010-2011 school year.

The last Teacher/Specialist meeting with the RCHS staff was held on April 22. The group will continue to meet next year and have already set meeting dates.

The PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports) committee is continuing the process of implementing this program in the school district. Missy Eid is doing a great job of working through the process with the staff. On May 18<sup>th</sup> there will be a one-half day "fast track" training for new members to the planning team. This will be held jointly with the Washburn staff.

The REACH committee is meeting to finalize the year. This was an awkward year in which there were some changes in the classes that were working in the program. Next year the intent is to have the REACH program in the 1-5 grades.
