Board Report

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Recently I attended the Wisconsin Indian Education Association (WIEA). Anne Sullivan, Carmen VandeVenter and I presented at the conference about the adoption of the Memorandum of Understanding between the District and the Tribe.

We sent a team to the CREATE conference. During the first day of the preconference we were able to get quite a bit of our Disproportionality plan completed. At the conference a group from the Red Cliff Head Start presented a session. Anne Sullivan and Andrea DeBungie were a part of a panel discussion on what we were doing here in Bayfield.

Currently we have 118 students in the Special Education program. We have 3 referrals that need to be completed.

We are looking at our graduation data from the past few years and trying to determine any patterns. I will be able to report more on that during the next few months.

Kindergarten Exploration and Enrollment went very well. We had 27 students attend. The response was very good and it seems that people are comfortable with this new format. The kindergarten teachers and Ms. Erickson are working with the Head Start teachers to decide on the kindergarten class lists. The future kindergarteners came for a family pizza night on April 9th and for breakfast on May 1st. They will also be coming for a visit on May 9th.
