ACHIEVEMENT AND CURRICULUM EXPANSION:

- Wisconsin Environmental Education Board Grant: Staff recently submitted a grant application entitled, “Making Connections: Our Health, Our environment and Our Economy to the Wisconsin Environmental Education Board. We just received word that a grant award of \$9,743.00 has been awarded to the district.
- Apostle Islands Area Community Fund: A \$3,000 grant has been received from the Apostle Islands Area Community Fund to support the “Birth-to-Five Literacy Program.”

- **Bayfield County Truancy Plan:** District representatives from Bayfield County School Districts are working with Judge Anderson and other county officials on revising the county truancy plan.
